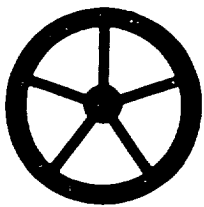

We hereby request approval of the unorthodox location for the subject well. Copies of a location plat, topographic map, and a map showing offsetting operators are attached for your reference. The Dakota formation was approved on a previous application. Consolidated inadvertently completed the Gallup formation on this well prior to applying for a Gallup unorthodox location in an attempt to prove additional reserves in this area.

The well was moved 25' to the north and 25' to the west as requested by the U. S. Forest Service. The old location was 1149' FNL & 1939' FEL. Drilling operations were completed September 28, 1984.
