As I informed you on Wednesday June 4, American Hunter Exploration is hereby responding to questions raised by Ernie Busch regarding our high angle/horizontal well, the AHEL Jicarilla 2A-1, located in the ne ne of section 2 T27N R1W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. In reviewing Case 10302, Order R-9538, Ernie noticed that the surface location authorized by the OCD in Santa Fe on June 27, 1991 did not match the surface location reported on the C-104 form submitted for his approval. Accordingly, he contacted me and asked that I review the matter with you to determine if any further action needed to be taken prior to final approval of C-104 by the OCD in Aztec.

In order to assist you with the review of this situation, I have enclosed a copy of the proposed C-104; a plat showing the surface location and drilling window authorized by Order R-9538, along with the actual, achieved surface location and drilling window; and a topographic map depicting the approved versus actual surface location.


