Mr. Jeff Kim has requested that I give him the cummulative cost of our four well drilling program. I have totalled up the daily estimated cost for drilling through intermediate casing, completion beginning with drilling the Gallup/Mancos open hole through placing the well on production, estimated the cost of installed and operating production equipment and estimated the cost of gas pipe line from the individual wells to the gas line being laid from Jicarilla 3F to the Northwest Pipeline system. The following sechedule of well costs are relatively accurate through drilling and casing, estimated fairly accurately through completion costs where the work has been done and estimated for future expected completion, production equipment and pipe line hookup costs.
