Gentlemen:

A recent Commission Order extended the Ballard Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool to include areas previously included in the Otero and Canyon Largo Pictured Cliffs Pools. The order stipulates that no well will be granted an allowable without a properly executed Form O-128 "Acreage Dedication Plat" being on file which shows the correct acreage to be dedicated to each well. This plat must be signed by an operator's representative testifying to the ownership of the acreage in the dedicated area.

In checking our files we find that a revised plat is needed on the following well operated by your Company in this area:

Pubco #3 Hughes Fed. M-34-26N-7W

As the effective date of the pool extension is May 1, 1959 it will be necessary that we have these plats immediately in order that the wells may be given proper allowables. If you have any questions in the matter please contact us.
