THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PRIMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN 27-5 UNIT WELL NO. 29, LOCATED 990 FRET FROM THE SOUTH LINE AND 990 FRET FROM THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NAPH, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED CLIFFS POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE HEANCO MESAVERDE POOL.

ORDER NO. DC-604



Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Pase Natural Gas Company, made application to the New Mexico Cil Genservation Commission on June 23, 1958, for permission to dually complete its San June 27-5 Unit Well No. 29, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 13, Tommship 27 North, Range 5 West, MMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pistured Cliffs Poel and the production of gas from the Blanco Messwords Poel.

Now, on this lat day of July, 1958, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the uniting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not sause wasts nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consenant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant hopein, El Pase Matural Cas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Sam Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 29, lessted 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 13, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, MMPM, Rie Agriba County, New Marico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Peal and the production of gas from the Blanco Messwerde Peal, through the easingtubing annulus and toe tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOMEVER. That subject well shall be completed and thereafter produced in such a manner that there will be no commingling within the well-bore, either within or outside the easing, of gas, oil and gas, or oil produced from either or both of the separate strata,

PROVIDED HONDERS. That prior to the actual dual completion the operator shall make pressure tests of the easing to prove that no easing leaks exist. In the event a easing leak is apparent the operator shall take appropriate steps to adequately repair the leak. The results of these tests shall be reported to the Commission on Form C-103.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well applicant shall submit to the appropriate District Office of the Commission copies of Oil Conservation Commission Form C-103, Form C-104, Form C-110, and Form C-122, outlining the information required on these forms by existing Rules and Regulations, and two copies of the electric log of the well.

PROVIDED PURTIER. That said subject well for dual completion and production shall be equipped in such a way that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for each of the two specified strata, and further, be equipped with all necessary connections required to permit recording meters to be installed and used at any time as may be required by the Commission or its representatives, in order that matural gas, sil, or oil and gas from each separate stratum may be accurately measured and the gas-eil or gas-liquid ratio thereof determined, and

provided Previous. That the operator shall make any and all tests, including segregation and packer-lockage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability fost Period for the Blance Heseverde Peel, commencing in the year 1959, and whenever the packer is disturbed, but not excluding any other tests and/or determinations as deemed necessary by the Commission; the original and all subsequent tests shall be witnessed by representatives of effect operators if any there he at their election, and the results jof each test, properly attested to by the applicant herein and all witnesses, shall be filed with the Commission within fifteen (15) days after the completion of such tests, and further, that applicant shall file with the Commission in duplicate a packer-cetting affidavit, which affidavit shall be due within fifteen (15) days of the dual completion or whenever the packer is disturbed, and

PROVIDED FURTHER. That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well, applicant shall submit to the Commission a diagrammatic mintals of the mechanical installation which was actually used to complete and produce the seal between the strate, and a special report of production, gas-oil ratio or gas-liquid ratio, and recurvoir pressure determination for each producing some or stratum immediately following completion.

retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seen necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-some production in the interests of conservation.
