

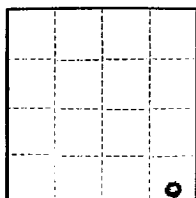

Run 105 jts. $4\frac{1}{2}$ " $5\frac{1}{2}$ " J-55 Std. thd CP&I casing with Baker washdown whirler float shoe at 3283, float collar at 3253, centralizers at 3268, 3222 and 3280. Welded two bottom joints.

Cemented w/150 sac 50-50 Pozmix and neat, with $\frac{1}{4}$ " gal, $1\frac{1}{2}$ "/sack Tufplug; circulation good, pump pressure 1000#, displaced w/54 bbls; bumped plug at 12:07 A.M., pressured up to 2000# for 5 minutes. Test OK.
