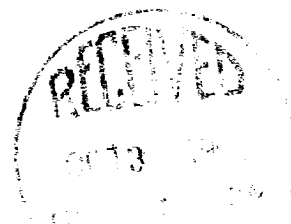

9-15-62 Ripped up Dowell to Free. Leased hole and breakdown with 120 lb, 1900 psi at 36 BPM. Traced down casing with 40,000 lb. 10-20 sand in 30,000 gallon. oil, 1700 psi at rate of 3 BPM. Flashed with 130 barrels oil 1800 psi at rate of 37 BPM. Instant shut in pressure 2000 psi, 15 min. shut in pressure 600 psi, on vacuum in 1 hour.
