DETAILS OF WORK

The well was drilled deeper to test the Dakota Sand. The cement in the float joint was drilled and a 4 3/4" hole was drilled from 5175' to 6050'. Three cones were taken in the Dakota & 2 SP's run - Electric logs were run to T.D. The open hole information did not indicate commercial production. The open hole section below the 5 1/2" casing was filled with cement and the bottom of the casing up to 5152'. The well will probably be sold to the British American Oil Co. to be used as an injection well for their proposed secondary recovery project. If British American does not purchase the well, we will make an effort to pull the casing and abandon the well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
