9-27-62 Rigger up Dwell to sand frac. Loaded hole and broke down with 175 HO at 2010 psi at 36 BPM. Frased down casing with 40,000 lb. 10-20 sand in 10,000 gal. oil. Pumped 10,000 lb. sand, 12,500 gal. oil at 1800 psi at 36 BPM. One Allison unit pumping. Pumped 10,000 lb. sand in 17,500 gal. oil 1400 to 1600 psi at rate of 27 - 29 BPM. Started flush at 1410 psi at rate of 27 BPM for 40 bbl. One blender quit. Continued pumping flush with one Allison - 21 HO at 1100 psi at rate of 8 - 10 BPM. Instant shut in pressure 950 psi, 15 min. shut in pressure 900 psi, on vacuum in one hour.
