Dear Sir:

This is to call your attention to the production from our Navajo Tribe "AR" Well No. 1 for the month of December, 1964.

This lease was over produced in the amount of 19 barrels above the maximum tolerance allowed by the Oil Commission. The over-production was due to a series of errors in recording the daily production. The pumper erroneously reported figures on December 23, 1964. He recorded 5' 5" instead of 10' 5". On December 10, 1964, he failed to include one run ticket in the production for the day. On December 24, 1964, he made the same mistake. These three errors amounted to 552 barrels of production not recorded on our production records. We were of the opinion that we were within the monthly allowable plus five days production. This 552 barrels over produced the lease by 19 barrels for the month.

We will eliminate the over-production during the month of January. We are also initiating extra measures to insure that this does not happen again. We will report this on the December C-115, as required by the Commission.

Dear Sir:

This is to call your attention to the production from our Wells "A" and "B" for the month of December, 1964.

This lease was over produced in the amount of 19 barrels above the maximum tolerance allowed by the Oil Commission. The over-production was due to a series of errors in recording the daily production. The pumpman erroneously reported figures on December 13, 1964. He recorded 21 1/2 instead of 19 1/2. On December 14, 1964, he failed to include one run which in the production for the day. On December 14, 1964, he made the same mistake. These three errors amounted to 52 1/2 barrels of over-production not recorded on our production records. We were of the opinion that we were within the monthly allowable plus five day production. This 52 1/2 barrels over produced the lease by 19 barrels for the month.

We will eliminate the over-production during the month of January. We are also instituting extra measures to insure that this does not happen again. We will report this on the December 31st, as required by the Commission.
