DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill well No. 2 to a depth of around 6350' to test the Gallup and Dakota formations. If both prove productive of commercial value, the well will be dual completed. Our casing program is as follows:

300' of 10-3/4" OD casing 32.75# H-40, cemented with 300 sacks cement. Cement to be circulated.

6350' of 5-1/2" OD casing, comb. 14# and 15.5#, J-55, RTAC, to be cemented with 500 sacks cement.

The designated drilling unit is the NW/4 - SW/4 Section 26-26N-11W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

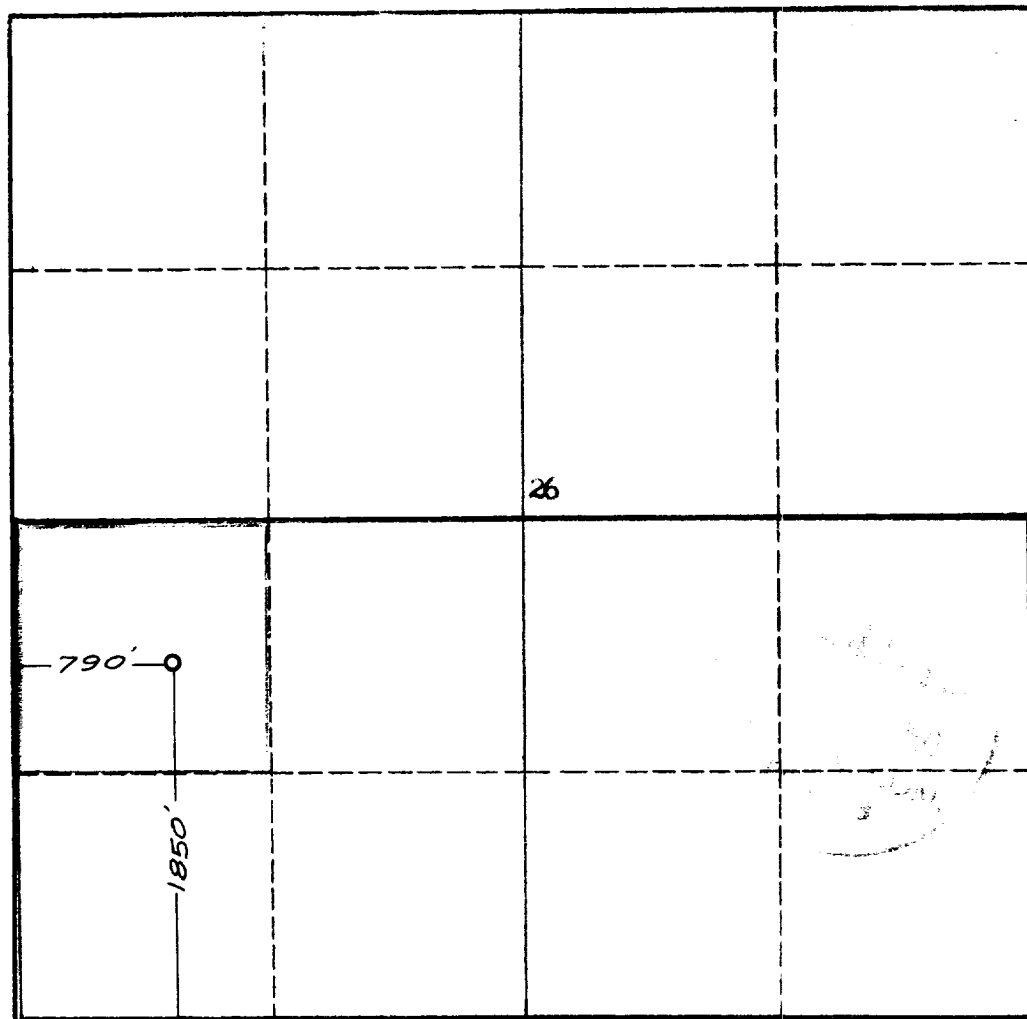
