DETAILS OF WORK

Well was temporarily abandoned on September 12, 1956. On October 16, 1961, 167 joints of 2" NKK tubing, total of 9291.18', landed at 3299.18' was run with 209 - 3/4" x 25' anchor rods. Well was put on pump on October 20, 1961. Well produced 22 barrels oil and 44 barrels water in 24 hours.
