Intend to plug well as follows:

(1) Knock out bridge plug at 5304'

(2) Surface squeeze perforations 5308-5316 and 5270-5294'.

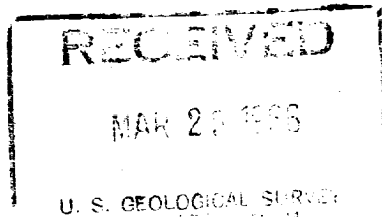
(3) Shoot off 5 1/2" casing at about 2000' and pull

(4) Spot 100' cement plug across pipe stub (50' in stub and 50' out of stub)

(5) Spot 10 sack cement plug in top of surface casing

(6) Erect dry hole marker and clean up location.

Well was completed in Sept. 1956 in Lower bench of Callup Sand. Operations suspended with 346 BIC to recover. Well was TA until August, 1961. Cum. oil prod. to 8-14-65 was 13,315 BO. Well was TA 8-14-65, after declining to 2 STB. Microlog shows only 2' of pay in Callup. No other commercial producing zone exists.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
