Gentlemen:

In accordance with Rule 504 of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, this is to request a 1,000 barrel oil test allowable for our Douthit "B" No. 3 well located in Section 29-26N-13W, Bisti Gallup Field, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The above mentioned well was temporarily abandoned on September 11, 1956, however, we now find it desirous to re-enter this well in an attempt to complete it as a producer. It is anticipated that this well will make the top allowable of 70 BOPD and the present status indicates a total of 350 barrels of load oil still to be recovered from the original completion attempt.

The Toronto Pipe Line Company will be the transporter for any oil recovered as reflected on Form C-110 filed with your office on January 9, 1958.
