It is understood that this request for such exception is based upon very extreme topographic conditions in the area.

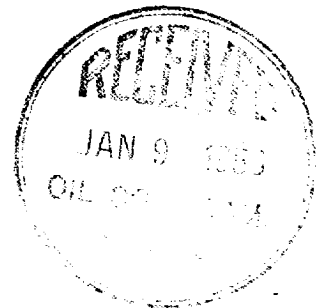
