The subject well was temporarily abandoned in May, 1984, by setting a CIBP at 5031', capping the plug with 25 sacks of cement, testing the casing to 400 psi, and displacing the casing with packer fluid. The well was TA'd so that it can be held for a possible future enhanced recovery project. We believe the steps taken to TA the well will preserve the wellbore in a useable condition and prevent communication between zones. We request an extension of one year on the approval to TA the well. We believe the best interest of conservation would be served by permitting the wellbore to remain TA'd until the feasibility of a future enhanced recovery project is determined.
