Casing Program:

- 4 1/2" at 600' with two stage tool set 100' below Mesa Verde & three stage tool 100' below Pictured Cliffs.
- 1st Stage - 300 sacks cement - 150% to cover 100' above Gallup top.
- 2nd Stage - 200 sacks cement - 150% to cover 100' above Cliff House top.
- 3rd Stage - 250 sacks cement - 150% to cover 100' above Alamogordo.

The W/2 of section 26 is dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


