A stage collar will be set under Pictured Cliffs at approx. 2500 ft. and cemented with approx. 600 cubic ft. cement.

Well will be Sand Fraced to stimulate production.

1-1/2", E.U.S., 2.900 tubing will be landed at 6875 ft. N.E.B.

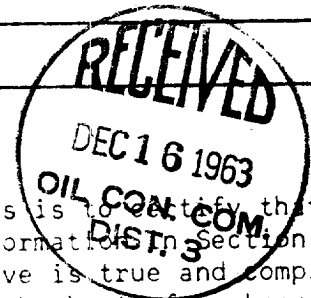
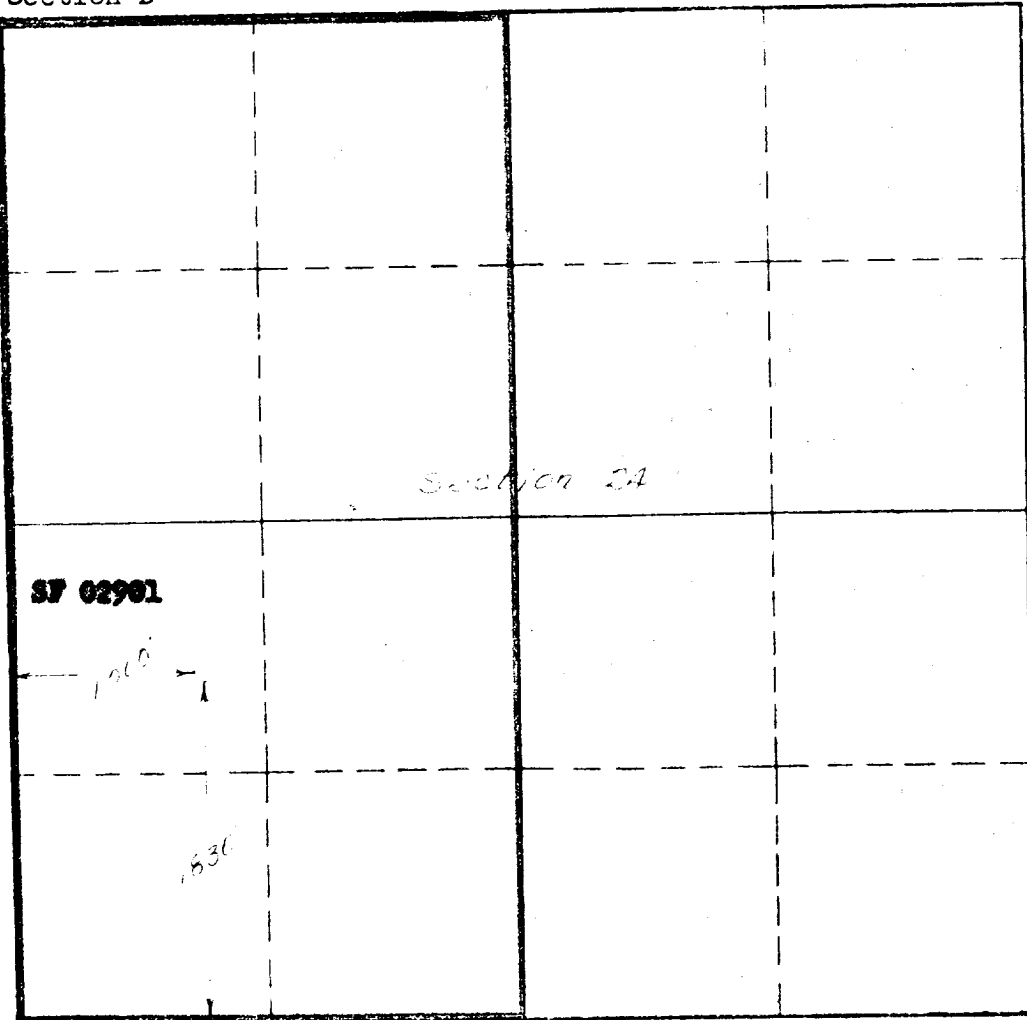
