DETAILS OF WORK

9-1-63
Pulled rods and tubing. Rigged up Western Company. Loaded hole with 140 EO and pumped to formation at 30 BPM at 2100 psi. Sand fractured with 30,000 gal. acid and 1,000 gal. controlled solubility phosphate, P-2 in 35,000 gal. oil. Mixed 500 gal. P-2 at end of 17,500 gal. and dropped 30 bridging balls. Pressure increased 300 psi when balls hit perforations. Mixed 500 gal. of P-2 at end of treatment. Finished with 140 EO. Average injection rate 39 BPM at 2100 psi. Twenty minute shut in pressure 1,000 psi.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations can be commenced.
