Attached please find Forms C-102 and C-104 changing the status of the subject well from gas to oil.

We placed the well on long term production test on May 15, 1968. The production rate on the May 22, 1968 test was 393 BO, 290 MCFD and a GOR of 739. Based on NMOCC Order No. R-2758, Rule No. 7, this well should now be classified as an oil well. We request that the status of the well be changed to "oil well" and on the basis of the May 22, 1968 test the allowable be set at top allowable of 334 BOPD effective June 1, 1968.
