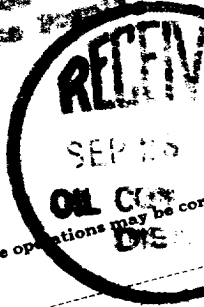
It is intended to drill a well thru the Pictured Cliff formation using every tool bit to perforate and water fracture possible producing zones. Estimate

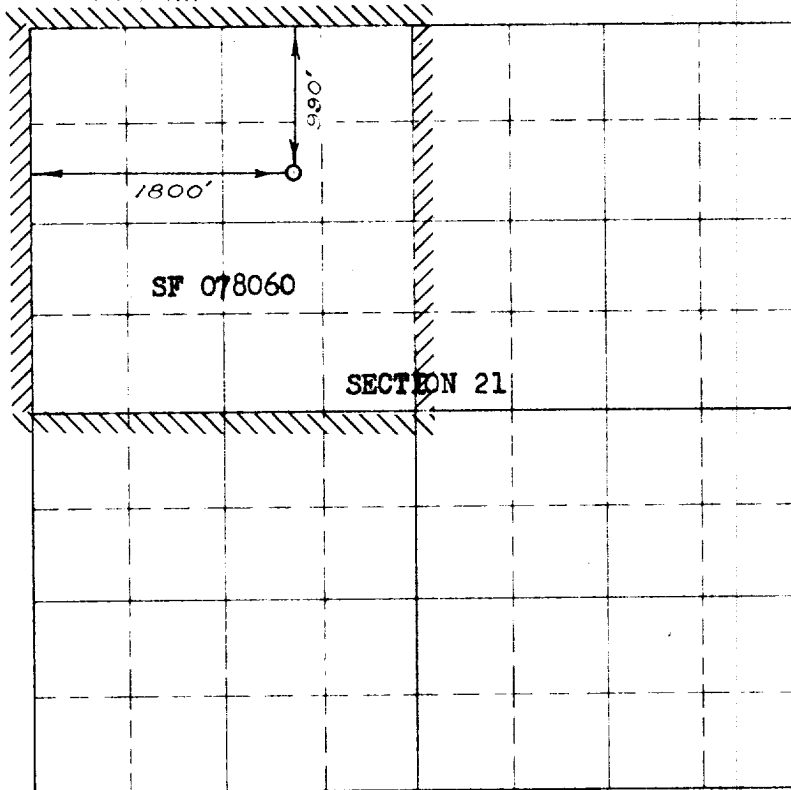
