- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tennessee Gas Transmission Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its USA W. O. Berger Well No. 4, located in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 22, Township 26 North, Range II West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Galleges-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel-strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A, as amended by Order R-1214.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Zone.
