We requested an exception to the No-Flare Order for the subject well in our letter of February 4, 1960. Subsequently we were granted an exception to April 1, 1960 by Administrative Order No. NFO-473. At the time we requested the original exception, we attached a letter from El Paso Natural Gas Company explaining why the well had not been connected to the low pressure casing-head gas collection system.

Presently, the same circumstances exist which were reported in the original application. Therefore, we request an additional sixty day extension to the original exception to the No-Flare Order.

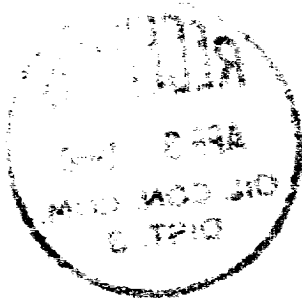
