The designated drilling unit is Lots 1 & 2, Section 19-26N-13W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

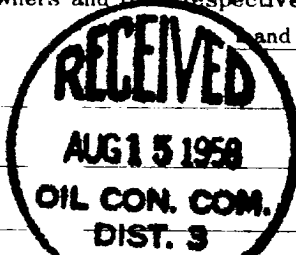

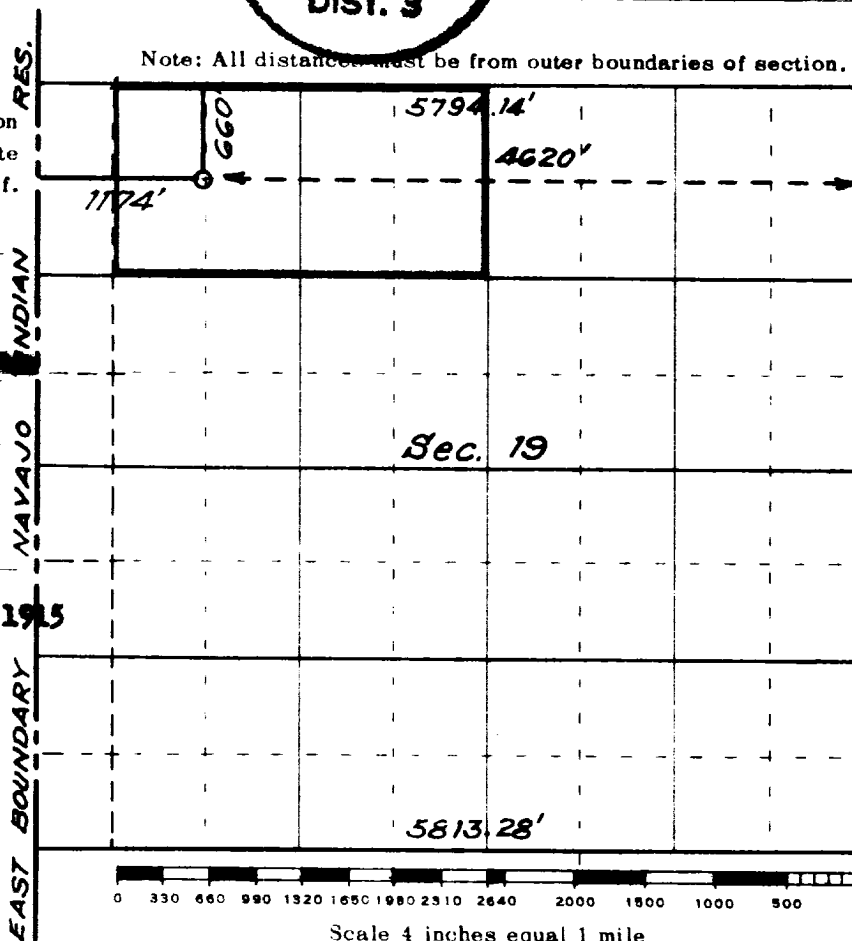
