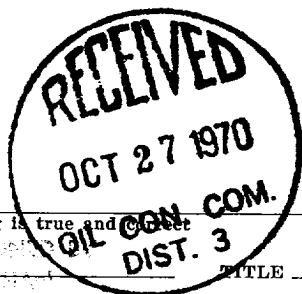

Subject well was tested as follows:

1. Filled tubing. Ran tubing with Lockset packer and tested for communication between perfs at 6216-26' and perfs at 6234-43'. Found no communication and unable to pump into perfs 6216-26'.
2. Set packer at 6231' with "F" nipple and sliding sleeve.
3. Tested 6234-43'.
4. Opened sliding sleeve and set blanking plug in "F" nipple.
5. Acidize 6216-26' with 1,000 gallons 15% HCl.
6. Swabbed well in and tested at 9295 MCFD.
7. Shut in well due to high GOR.

As this well has proven to be a gas well, it is desired to reclassify it from an oil well to a gas well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
