

THE APPLICATION OF SOUTHWEST PRODUCTION COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS BOND FEDERAL WELL NO. 1 LOCATED IN THE SE/4 SW/4 OF SECTION 13, TOWN-SHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, MMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE PICTURED CLIFFS FORMATION ADJACENT TO THE BALLARD-PICTURED CLIFFS POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BASIN-DAKOTA POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (II) Southwest Production Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on June 19, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Bond Federal Well No. 1 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs Formation adjacent to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Mow, on this 10th day of July, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section (II) of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREPORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southwest Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Bond Pederal Well Mo. 1 located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 8 West, MMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs Formation adjacent to the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section II, Rule 112-A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or pretection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-some production in the interests of conservation.
