DETAILS OF WORK

The above well was spudded January 2, 1963 and drilled to a depth of 400'. 13-3/8" casing was set at 391' with 500 sacks of cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Circulated 275 sacks. After waiting on cement, tested casing with 500 pounds. Test ok. Reduced hole to 11" at 391' and resumed drilling.
