12-8 Moved in, rigged up, displaced hole w/water.

12-9 POH w/1-1/2" tbg. Ran csg inspection log. PU 2" EUE tbg w/full bore packer & cast iron BP set @ 6000', pressure tested to 3000#. Found upper hole in csg @ 3132' & lower hole @ 4272'.

12-10 Set packer @ 2911'. Cemented w/800 sx 50/50 Pozmix & Class C + 8% gel & 1# Tuf-plug/sk and 50 sx reg. Class C + 2% calcium chloride. Over-displaced cement thru hole @ 3132' w/2 1/2 bbls wtr. WOC 5 hrs. Squeezed w/250 sx 50/50 Pozmix & Class C + 8% gel & 50 sx reg. Class C + 2% calcium chloride. Maximum squeeze pressure 3000#. Left approx. 150' cement in csg above hole @ 3132'.

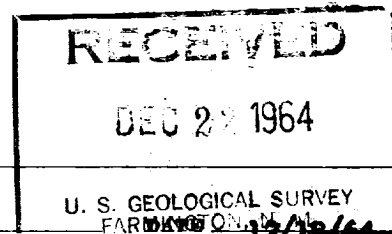
12-11 WOC 13 hrs. Drid. cement 2926 - 3132'. Tested csg to 1500#. Drid. cement 3350 - 3550'. Ran Baker full bore, found small hole @ 3600', larger leak @ 4272'.

12-12 Perf 4 holes 4272-73'. Ran packer to 3385'. Squeezed 200 sx 50/50 pozmix & Class C + 8% gel & 75 sx reg. Class C to 1500#. WOC 13 hrs. Drid cement 3420 - 3800'. Tested csg to 1500#.

12-13 Drid. cement to 4282'. Pressure tested csg, drld BP @ 6005'. POH laying down 2" tbg.

12-14 Ran 194 jts 1 1/2" NU tbg. landed @ 6368'.

12-15 Well kicked off @ 11:00 PM.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
