NOW, on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced and the recommendations of the Examiner, E. J. Fischer, and being fully advised in the premises,

**FINDS:**

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, is the operator of the Huerfano Unit Well No. 104, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 17, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the above-described Huerfano Unit Well No. 104 in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup oil pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota gas pool through parallel strings of 2-inch tubing.

(4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.

(5) That approval of the subject application will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

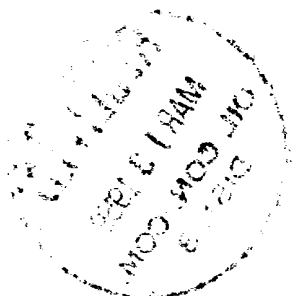

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Esmerale Unit Well No. 104, located in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 17, Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup oil pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota gas pool through parallel strings of 2-inch tubing.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the subject well.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
