**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Order No. R-1638, The British-American Oil Producing Company has made application to the Commission on August 24, 1963, for permission to expand its West Bisti Unit Pressure Maintenance Project in the Bisti-Gallup Oil Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

NOW, on this 23rd day of September, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Order R-1638.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1638.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-referenced water flood project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, The British-American Oil Producing Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the Gallup formation through the following described well for purposes of Pressure Maintenance to wit:

West Bisti Unit Well No. 59 located in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 26 North, Range 14 West, NMPM.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall inject water through tubing with a packer set well below the top of the cement surrounding the oil string of said well.

1. That application was duly filed in due form.
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all
class operators have been duly notified of the application.
3. That no objection has been received within the waiting
period as prescribed by Order R-1938.
4. That the proposed injection well is eligible for conversion
to water injection under the terms of Order No. R-1938.
5. That the proposed expansion of the above-mentioned water
flood project will not cause waste nor injure correlative rights.
6. That the application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, The British-American Oil Producing Company,
be and the same is hereby authorized to inject water into the
Galing formation through the following described well for purposes
of Pressure Maintenance to unit:

West Basti Unit Well No. 23 located in the SW 1/4 of Section
15, Township 23 North, Range 12 West, T13N, R12W.

PROVED WORKING: That applicant shall inject water through
casing with a packer set well below the top of the cement surround-
ing the oil string of said well.
