4-11-68 moved in and rigged up pulling unit. Pulled on tubing with 58,000# but unable to unseat Guiberson packer at 4898'. Free point indicated tubing free above packer. Ran jet cutter and cut tubing at 3068'. Spotted 15 sack cement plug 3068-2918'. Pulled 100 joints (3051') of 2-3/8" OD J-55 tubing.

Welded on pull nipple, set jacks, and worked casing with 160,000# tension. Shot 5-1/2" casing at 2814'; casing pulled free. Pulled and laid down 5 joints of casing to set cement plug over casing stub. Spotted 20 sack cement plug, 3% gel from 2764-2864'. Pulled 17 joints (533') of 5-1/2" 17# 8R J-55 L-T&C condition "C" casing and 70 joints (2298') of 5-1/2" 15.5# 8R J-55 condition "C" casing. Set 10 sacks of cement in top of surface casing with dry hole marker.
