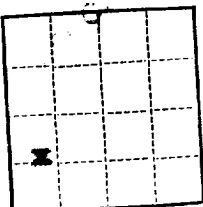

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill with rotary tools to the top of the Pictured Cliff formation - expected between 1,900 feet and 2,100 feet below surface - then drill 4-3/4" rat hole through Pictured Cliff formation. Completion with cable tools - and shoot with solidified nitro glycerin, or sand oil fracture. (Method to be determined later)

Casing program: 100 feet of 8-5/8" OD new 8 rd. thd. sals. casing. Circulate cement to surface.

5-1/2" OD 11# J-55 Sals. casing to be set on top of Pictured Cliff formation, cemented w/ 125 sacks regular cement.

1" tubing to be set within 50 feet of total depth for production.

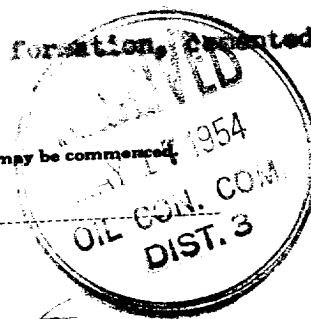

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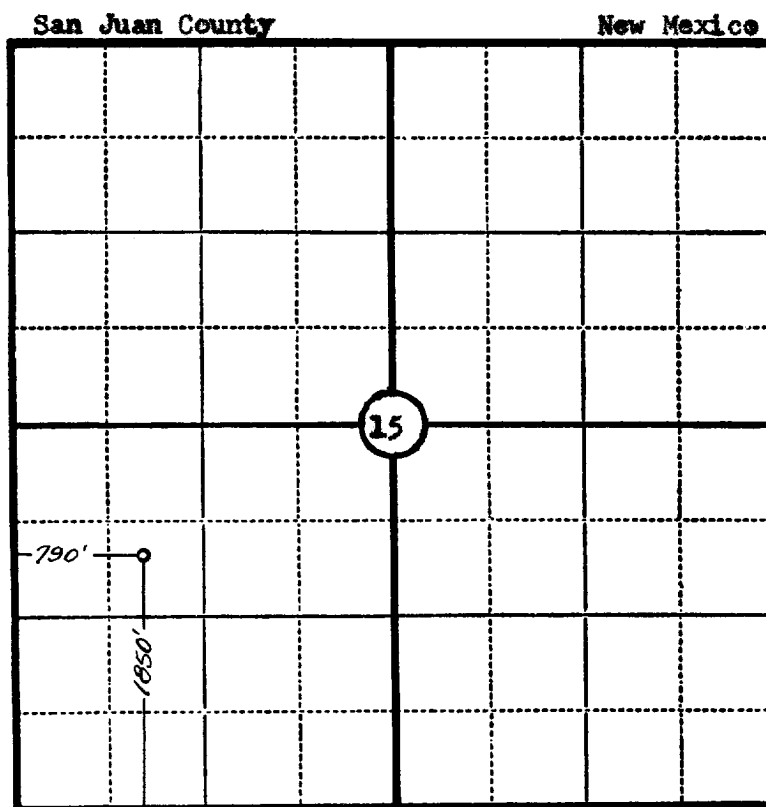
