#### COURT OF THE COMMISSION

## BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for bearing at 7 o'clock a.m. on March 16, 1955, at Sente Fe, Mow Mentoo, before the Oll Concervation Commission of New Mentoo, bestinator referred to as the "Commission".

MOW, on this 20 day of April, 1968, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adveced and the emblets received at each bearing, and being fally advised in the premises,

## 7900:

- 1. That due notice of the time and place of bearing and the purpose thereof boding been given as required by law, the Gemmissian has jurisdiction of this cours and the subject matter thereof.
- 3. That applicants, Wood River Oil and Refining Company and The 21 Devado Refining Company, are the swares of State of New Mentes Oil and One Leane 3-10094-6, which leave includes the M/2 SW/4 and the SW/4 SW/4 of Saction 16, Township 26 North, Range 7 West, MMPM, San Juan County, New Mentes.
- 3. That the above-described lands are elimated within the boundaries of the Energies Walt but are not committed to eald unit.
- 4. That the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 16, Township 26 North, Range 9 West, MAPM, San Jann County, New Mexico, is bold under a State of New Mexico Oil and Gas Lease executed in favor of New Mexico Western Oil and Gas Company.

ILLEGIBLE

- 5. That there lands described to Fluding 4 shore are situated within the boundaries of the Musriane Unit and are committed to the unit.
- 6. That is order to form a standard 160-acre drilling unit in the SW/4 of Section 16, Township 26 North, Range 7 Woot, NMPM, it would be necessary for the applicants to communities those lands hold by the applicants and described in Finding 2 above with those lands hold by New Mexico Western Oli and Gas Gempany, which lands are described in Finding 4 above and which lands are committed to the Euserine Unit Agreement.
- 7. That it is notiber advisable nor practical to effect the communitiestics of lands committed to a unit agreement with lands not committed to that agreement.
- 8. That New Mexico Western Oil and Gas Company and the El Pase Natural Gas Georgeny have extered an objection to the formation of a 130-acre non-standard drilling unit as proposed by Wood River Oil and Refining Georgeny and The El Dorodo Reflaing Georgeny.
- 7. That, despite the objection, it is openeary to provide applicants with a non-standard 130-nero drilling unit so that they may be afforded the opportunity to drill a well on the acrosps described in Finding 2 above.
- 10. That the formation of such 120-acre non-standard providen unit will be in the best interests of conservation and will promote the orderly development of the acce.

## it is therefore ordered:

i. That the application of the Wood River 4(1 and Refining Company and The XI Deredo Refining Company for approval of a 130-acre morthodox drilling unit consisting of the following described acrongs,
