Dear Mr. McGrath:

We are in receipt of your Office Memorandum dated February 2, 1959, advising that you had received two carbon copies of Form 9-330, Log of Oil and Gas Well on our NavaJo #3 well, 13-26N-14W.

The only reason we can figure that you did not get the original and two copies of the logs for the New Mexico Commission is because they were mis-mailed from here. Mr. Emory C. Arnold, District Supervisor of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, probably received the material that should have gone to your office. By copy of this letter, we are requesting Mr. Arnold to forward those copies with the logs attached to you at P. O. Box 965, Farmington, New Mexico. If Mr. Arnold did not receive the above mentioned logs, we will appreciate his advising us of that fact.

Upon your receipt of the logs from the New Mexico Commission, we would appreciate very much if you would forward those copies you received with the attached logs and completion reports to Mr. Arnold at 1000 Rio Brazos Road, Aztec, New Mexico. By doing this, we will eliminate having reproduced costly micrologs and electric logs that would have to be secured if we submit new reports.

If this is not satisfactory, please advise.
