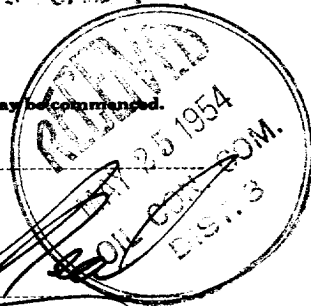
Propose to drill with rotary tools to the top of the Pictured Cliff Formation - expected between 1,900 feet and 2,100 feet below surface - then drill 4-1/2" cat hole through Pictured Cliff formation. Completion with cable tools - and mudding with solidified nitro glycerin or sand oil fracturing.

Casing program: 100 feet of 3-5/8" new B no. and 32" casing. Cement to surface.

1 1/2" O.D. 17' seamless casing to be set on top of Pictured Cliff's gravel. Cement with 140 sacks regular cement.

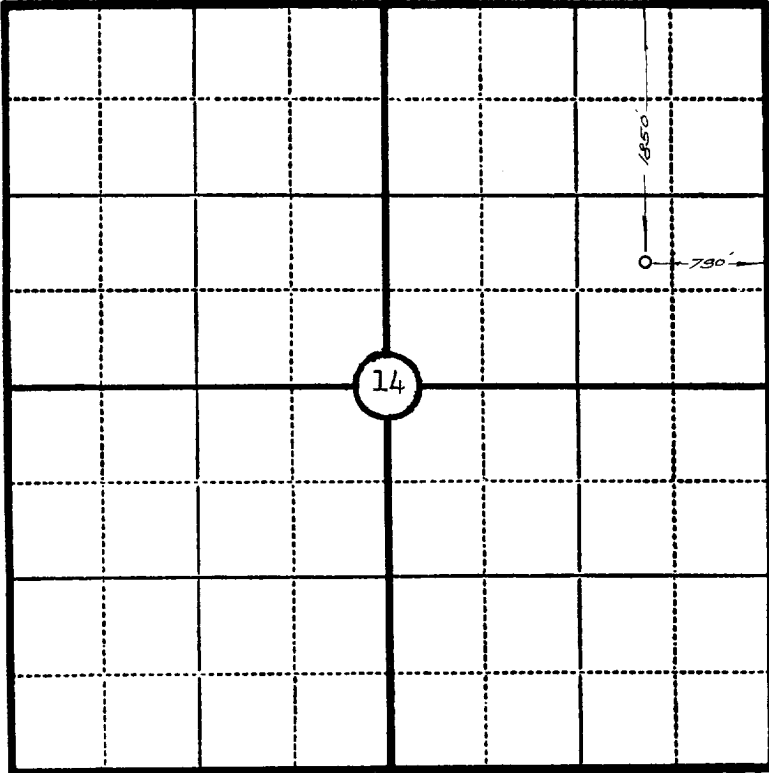
