**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Skelly Oil Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 6, 1959, for permission to dually complete its O. H. Randel Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallegos-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 26th day of July, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

That the applicant herein, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its O. H. Randel Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallegos-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

**PROVIDED HOWEVER,** That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

**PROVIDED FURTHER,** That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota zone.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:** That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A (c) Skeely Oil Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on July 6, 1939, for permission to dually complete its O. H. Now, on this 26th day of July, 1939, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Section 10 of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oilier acreage have been duly notified, and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair corrective rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Skeely Oil Company, be and the same be hereby authorized to dually complete its O. H. Randel Well No. 1, located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 11 West, NPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallegos-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion, and annually thereafter during the annual deliverability test period for the Dakota zone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That production of this case is hereby reserved by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and for protection of

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correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
