That the applicant herein, Skelly Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its O. H. Randel Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 14. Township 26 North, Range Il West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Gallegos-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.
