- Run 1 1/2" 5/8", 12.30, 12.40 surface casing on July 11, 1958. Casing landed at 90' SL. Cemented with 80 sacks regular with 11 Calcium Chloride. Cement circulated to surface.
- Pressured up on surface casing on August 1, 1958 to 500 psi for 30 minutes, pressure held.
