

## DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill with rotary tools to the top of the Pictured Cliff Formation - expected between 1,900 feet and 2,100 feet below surface - then drill 4-1/4" rat hole through Pictured Cliff formation. Completion with cable tools - and shooting with solidified nitro glycerin.

Casing program: 100 feet of 8-5/8" new 8 rd. thd. 32# Casing. Circulate cement to surface.

5-1/2" od 17# seamless casing to be set on top of Pictured Cliff formation, cemented w/ 150 sacks regular cement.

1" tubing to be set within 50 feet of total depth for production.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.


