4. Spotted 60 sacks from 6300 to 6450 (Top of Lower Permian 6351).
5. Spotted 40 sacks from 4935 to 5035 (Top of Pennsylvanian 4985).
6. Spotted 40 sacks from 3700 to 3800 (Top of BeChelly 3765).
7. Spotted 60 sacks from 2800 to 2150 (Top of Bakken 2890 and Todillo).
8. Spotted 40 sacks from 1450 to 1580 (Bottom of surface casing at 1527).
9. Spotted 10 sacks surface to 30' and erected abandonment marker.
10. Location has been cleaned up.
