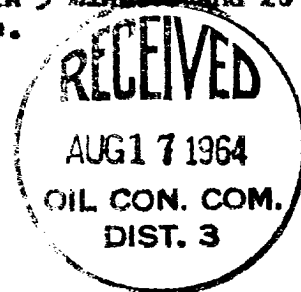

On August 2, 1964 we converted the above well to water production for use as a supply well for drilling operations as follows:

- (1) Moved in and rigged up double drum unit.
- (2) Drilled out 30 sack cement plug at surface and cleaned out cement stringers and mud to 1480'.
- (3) Set 8-5/8" Baker Model "X" cast iron bridge plug at 1431'.
- (4) Perforated 1 shot per foot 1295-1285; 1220-1205; 1185-1175; 955-935; a total of 55 holes. Well flowing 6-1/2 gallons per minute.
- (5) Landed 2-3/8" tubing at 236' and nipple up well.
- (6) Set pumping unit on temporary base and began testing well.
- (7) Well completed 8-9-64 and tested 55 gallons of water in 3 minutes and 20 seconds. Well pumping 12-1/2 - 28" strokes per minute.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
