DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools thru the Lower Gallup formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Point Lookout and set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Lower Gallup and production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated and fractured.

Casing Program:

10 3/4" at 170' with 200 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 4100' with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" Liner 5270' with 300 sacks cement.

The SE SW/4 of section 7 is dedicated to this well.

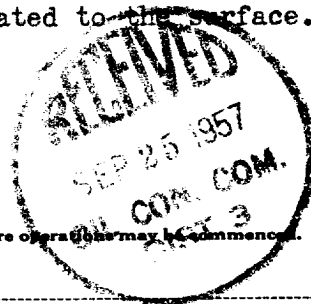

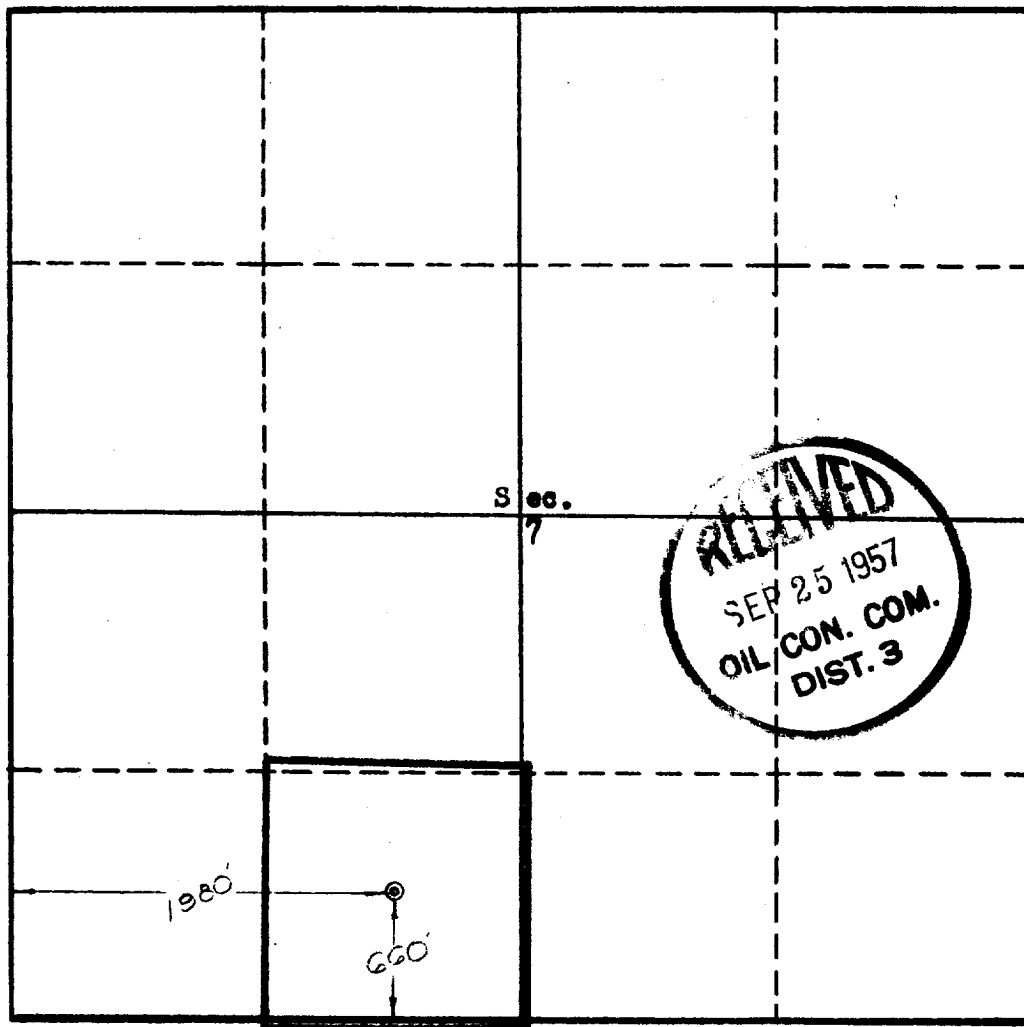
