1. Spudded 12 1/4" surface hole January 29, 1964. Drilled to total depth of 105 feet R.K.B. Ran 3 joints 8 5/8", 24.0#, J-55 casing. Landed at 105 feet R.K.B. Cemented with 80 sacks regular cement with 2% Calcium Chloride. Plug down 2:30 A.M. January 30, 1964.
2. Nipped up and pressure tested surface casing to 500 psi for 15 minutes. Test OK. Drilled out from under surface casing on January 30, 1964, with 7 7/8" hole.
3. Drilled 7 7/8" hole to total depth of 2502 feet R.K.B. Ran 74 joints 4 1/2", J-55 9.50# casing, Landed at 2494 R.K.B. Cemented with 150 sacks 50-50 pozmix cement with 2% gel. Plug down 5:00 P.M. February 3, 1964. Pressure up on plug 1500 PSI. Okay.
4. Total depth 2494. Plug back total depth 2465. Perforated 1 shot at following depths: 2280, 2307, 2310, 2313, 2318, 2324, 2327, 2330, and 1 shot per foot at following intervals 2353-2356, 2359-2369 and 2372-2379. Total of 28 perforations. Sand Water and Carbon Dioxide frac perforations with 40,000# 10-20 mesh sand and 25,500 gallons of water containing 20 tons of liquid Carbon Dioxide.
5. Blowed and cleaned well. Ran 71 joints of 1", 1.70#, JCW tubing. Landed at 2253 feet R.K.B. Completed well February 10, 1964.

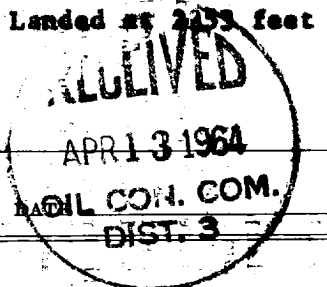

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
