In reference to your letter of October 19, 1987 (copy attached) regarding the No. 6 Huerfanito, the well has not been plugged and abandoned.

This well, as well as all other Mobil wells in northwestern New Mexico, were recently transferred from MFTM to the Denver - West Division. We were not aware that your approval had been obtained to abandon the well. A review of the files available in the Cortez office indicates that we will probably wish to proceed with the work as approved. However, we request an extension of the approval until July 1, 1988 so that we can conduct a more thorough review of the well, obtain the necessary company authorizations and complete the work.
