In reference to your letter of July 13, 1988 (copy attached) regarding the Huerfanito 6-11, the well has not been plugged and abandoned.

A recent review of the property indicates that the Gallup has potential in this wellbore. However, the economics of such a recompletion do not meet Mobil's minimum criteria. This property is currently for sale and it is probable that a smaller operator might be able to economically justify a recompletion into the Gallup. Plugging of the well would also jeopardize such a sale. Mobil Oil Corporation therefore requests that the prior approval to plug and abandon the subject well be rescinded.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 6 Huerfanito, SE/4SW/4 sec. 11, T. 26 N., R. 9 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease NM-012737 and your Sundry Notice dated October 21, 1987, which requested an extension to plug this well until July 1, 1988. If the well has been plugged, you are required to submit a subsequent report of abandonment. If the well has not been plugged, then you are required to plug the well within 30 days.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

You are further advised that any instructions, orders or decisions issued by the Bureau of Land Management are subject to an administrative review pursuant to 43 CFR 3165.3 and appeal pursuant to 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.700.
