RE: Disposal of Produced Water Filters

Dear Mr. Nicol:

Walsh Engineering and Production Company (Walsh) acting as agent for Pendragon Energy Partners (Pendragon) has requested authorization to dispose of produced water filters from the Pendragon Frontier A #1 SWD, I-08-26N-12W, API#30-045-05919. At my request, West Hahn of Walsh had the filters tested for corrositivity. The sample filters tested 7.8 and 7.9 pH. These results are well within the non-hazardous spectrum, allowing the water filters [Rule 712 D (2) m. waste] to be disposed of at a New Mexico Environmental Department (NMED) permitted landfill. Pendragon must furnish test results to the NMED permitted facility that meet its permitted standard.
