Run & set 5 1/2" casing at 5227' & cemented with 125 sks. reg. & 125 cu. ft. Stratacrete.
Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 5209'.

Perforated 5 1/2" casing 5187-55' with 4 Schlumberger jet shots to test cement job.
Perforated 5 1/2" casing 5151-5187' with 4 Schlumberger jet shots per ft. Total of 36',
144 shots.

Fraced 5 1/2" casing perforations 5151-5188' with 40,000 gal. of 20-40 fine sand & 37,842 gal. of crude oil. BDP 1100#, Max. TP 2500#, Min. TP 2350#, inj. rate 53.1 BPM.
Time of treatment 22 min. Shut-down pressure 700#.
