Gentlemen:

On March 28, 1970 you submitted a "Subsequent Report of Abandonment" for well No. 1 Luthy, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 11, T. 26 N., R. 8 W., N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. The way in which this well is plugged is not acceptable as the Mesaverde formation behind the production casing is not covered with cement. When the casing corrodes it will allow the Mesaverde fluids to commingle with Ojo Alamo water. As there is cement behind the pipe approximately to the base of the Ojo Alamo a cement plug inside the pipe from 1500 to 1700 feet should prevent the commingling of Mesaverde and Ojo Alamo fluids. Please see that this plug is placed in the well and resubmit the "Subsequent Report of Abandonment". Also fill the pits and clean up the location.
