*Dear Mr. Fisher:*

*You should have received application for dual completion on El Paso Natural Gas Company's #92 Huerfano Unit, E-7-26N-9W. This well is applied for as a gas-gas dual in the Dakota and Gallup zones. You will note that the packer leakage test submitted with this well is not conclusive as to whether the zones are separated. The well could be tested on one side only because of the single tubing string completion.*

*I have talked to Mr. Oberly, Engineer with El Paso Natural Gas Company about this well and he informs me that the Gallup seems to be making enough oil so that it is going to be necessary to re-enter the well and install dual tubing strings. Mr. Oberly informed me that this work will commence probably this week. I would therefore suggest that you hold this application pending further developments.*

You should have received application for that permit on 12-28-53. I have  
checked the company's file and found that the well is  
applied for as a gas well in the Llanos and Chaparral areas. You  
will note that the proper language was submitted with this well to  
not consider as a gas well and as a gas well. The well could  
be tested on the side only because of the right of way  
completion.

I have talked to Mr. E. J. Fischer with the New Mexico Oil Company  
about this well and he informs me that the drilling seems to be making  
enough oil so that it is going to be necessary to re-enter the well  
and install that tubing string. Mr. Fischer informed me that this work  
will commence probably this week. I would therefore suggest that you  
hold this application pending further developments.
