This letter is to inform you that El Paso Natural Gas Company is in the process of dually completing the following well:

Huerfano Unit No. 92 (DG)

NW 7-26-9

This well will be dually completed in the Dakota-Graneros formation and in the Gallup formation with the Dakota-Graneros to be treated as one producing zone.

This well is intended as a gas-gas dual. A production packer will be set on 2" EUE tubing between the two zones, with a circulating sleeve installed in the tubing above the production packer. Upon final completion a formal application for administrative approval will be submitted to the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe.
